To make a single t-shirt can require **more than 700 gallons of water**. And despite this high cost, a clothing item typically **lasts only three years**.


Ask your Apparel Vendor about their Sustainable Options...

- 1. Hanes supplies t-shirts and sweatpants as well as other popular apparel options
- 2. Most of the cotton used by Hanes is sourced locally from Southeastern United States
- 3. Hanes has reduced their water usage by 30%
- 4. They have shifted **41% of their energy use** to renewable sources
